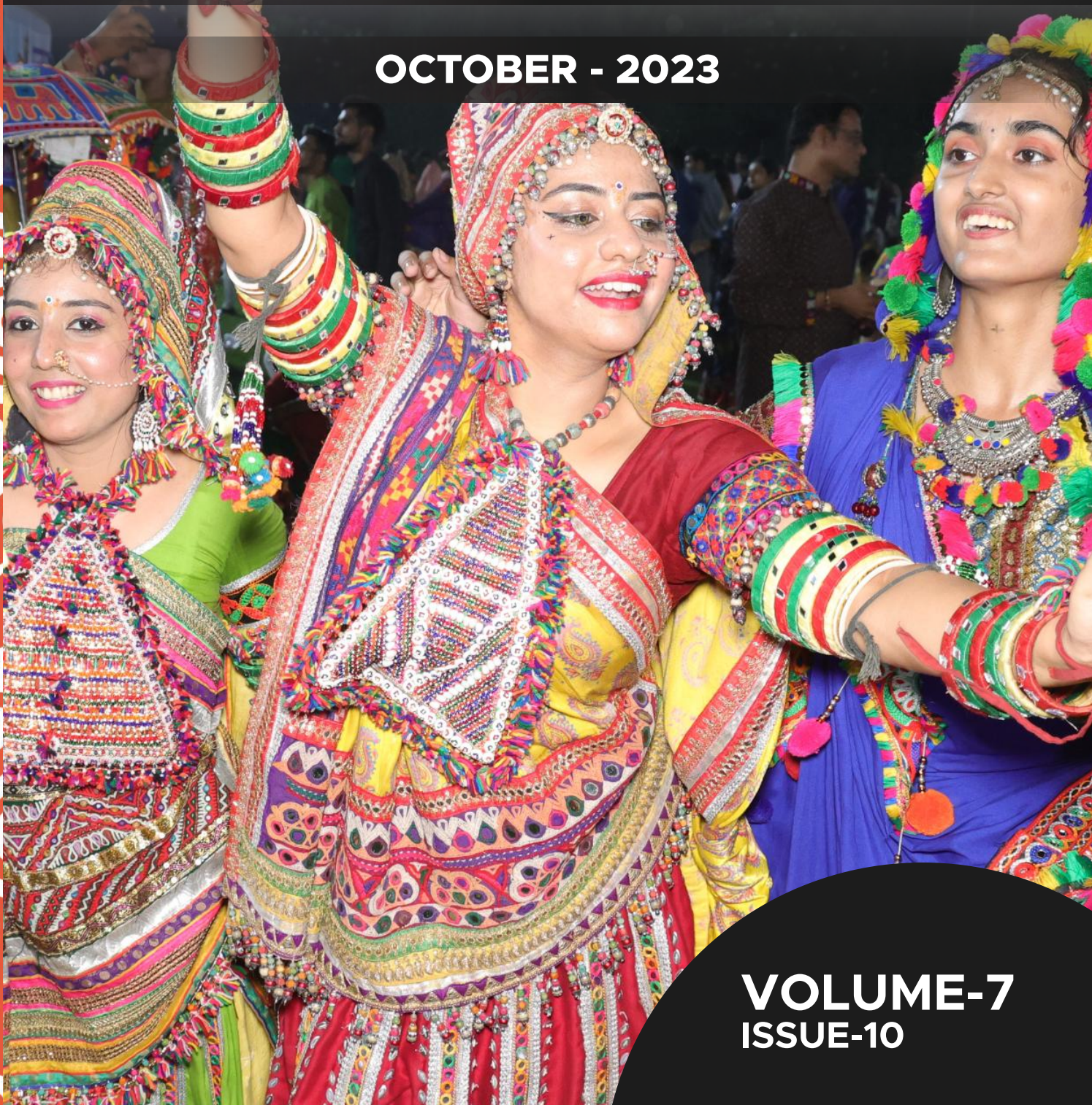

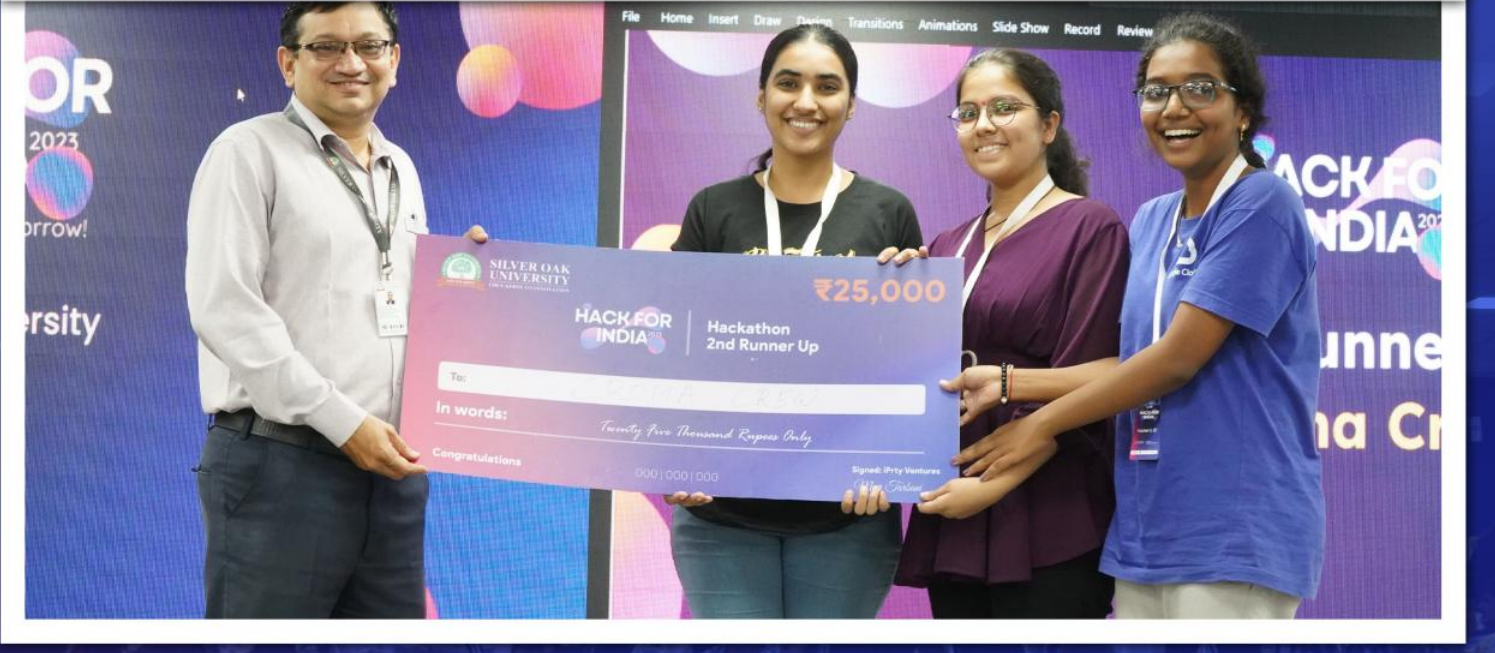

ACADEMIA TO INDUSTRY - An Industrial Visit

Two day laboratory visit was organized by the Department of Microbiology of Silver Oak University at Neuberg Supratech Laboratory, Ahmedabad. One of the most reputable brands in pathology diagnostics right now is Neuberg Supratech. This visit brought laboratory exposure to the students of bachelors and masters under the supervision of Dr. Rupal Shah, Dr. Edwin Pithawala, Dr. Urja Pandya, Krishna Shah and Brinda Panchal. Total 80 students participated in the visit. The laboratory had 4 sections of processing samples mainly Solid oncology, Haematology, Inherited Disorder and Reproductive medicine sections. These whole functions under the research and diagnostic department. The main component of this laboratory was the extraction, mainly Sanger library used for sequencing of DNA base pairs around 600 bp and the ROS instrument which gives results in 2 hrs and has 96 samples run in a single time. This laboratory has also well maintained DNA libraries and RNA libraries. The students had the chance to have their questions about their particular subjects answered. Students were given the opportunity to ask specialists questions at the end of the visit, and the compassionate responses of the experts satisfied the student's thirst. The goal of the visit is to learn about cutting-edge genomics and bioinformatics research connected to human health.

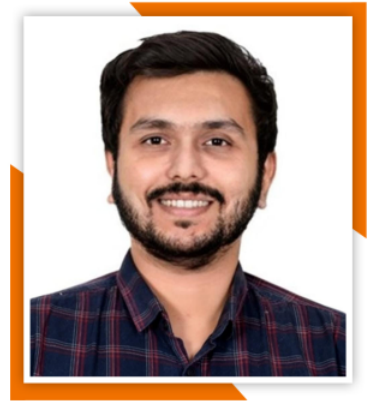

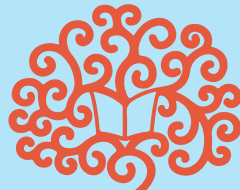
