SEMINAR SERIES @ SOIS

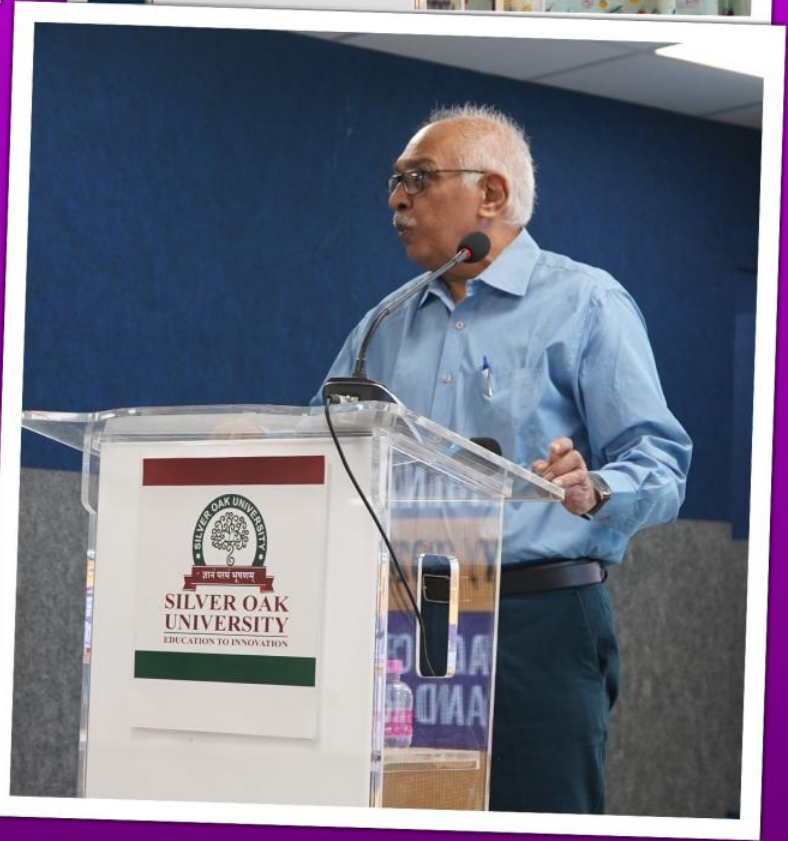

THE UNTETHERED SOUL THE JOURNEY BEYOND YOURSELF A BOOK REVIEW

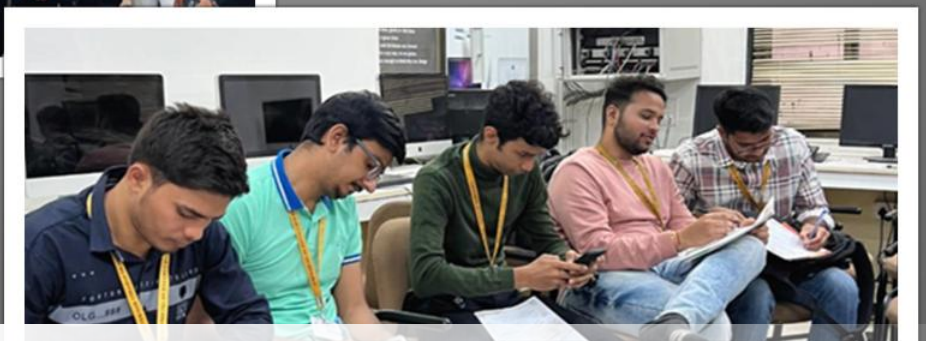

FULL STACK INNOVATIONS @ GDSC & IEEE

"Full Stack Innovations" was organized by Google Developer Student Clubs, Silver Oak University in collaboration with Silver Oak University IEEE Computer Society Student Branch Chapter and Node Ahmedabad Community. The event showcased two prominent speakers, Mr. Nisharg Shah, Founder and Organizer of Node Ahmedabad, Software Development Consultant at AJIO, Technical Lead at OpenXcell and Mr. Swapnil Soni, Senior Software Developer at Hyathi Technologies. The sessions were conducted on 23rd, 24th and 27th January, 2024 at the C.V. Raman Hall with 93 participants.

With a practical learning approach in mind, Mr. Nisharg Shah delved into the Fundamentals of JavaScript, emphasizing hands-on experience over theoretical knowledge. Mr. Shah encouraged participants to adopt a practical approach in their learning journey. During the session, he shared his preference for WebStorm over VS Code and covered various aspects, including types of Consoles and the usage of NVM to switch React versions. Demonstrating a Counter implementation in Vanilla JS, Mr. Shah elaborated on the Document Object Model (DOM), highlighting its importance, and presenting a few use cases. He guided participants through the creation of a Reset Button.

On the second day, Mr. Nisharg Shah delved into the practical aspects of software development, guiding participants through the creation of a Counter with increment and decrement buttons using JavaScript and DOM manipulation. The workshop further delved into package management tools such as npm, yarn, and pnpm, emphasizing the importance of practical impact and demonstrating both parallel and serial installations.

On the final day, Mr. Swapnil Soni covered HTTP concepts, server-client relationships, and explained boilerplate code. Attendees gained a deep understanding of JSON files, followed by practical demonstrations. Mr. Soni elaborated on API and CRUD operations, highlighting their significance in backend development. Yash Simejiya, Student Ambassador of Syncloops at Silver Oak University, delivered a brief talk on Syncloop. Following this, a quiz was conducted, and the top three winners were rewarded with goodies from Syncloop. The session concluded with Swapnil Soni's practical demonstration, creating a Chatbot similar to ChatGPT and an API practical with Gen A.I.

Mr. Ankkrit Sheth set the tone with an insightful exploration of the topic "Evolving to Serverless." He smoothly explained serverless computing basics, highlighted Operational Responsibility and event-driven Architecture's importance, and compared traditional EC2 instances with serverless Lambda functions. He offered a practical roadmap for effective use. The second session unfolded under the guidance of Ms. Omsree Butani. In a comprehensive exploration of the AWS Serverless Platform, Ms. Butani covered key components such as AWS Lambda, S3, Amazon API Gateway, Amazon CloudWatch, and AWS EventBridge. Transitioning into serverless architecture patterns, Ms. Butani provided insights into applications across microservices, mobile backend, web applications, and real-time analytics engines.

Ultimately, the workshop promoted self-expression, critical thinking, and a deeper appreciation for the rich tradition of ceramic arts.



STIPEND BASED INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Training and Placement cell is dedicated to ensuring the optimal placement of students by consistently working on their preparation through internship programs. These programs are carefully crafted to offer a thorough and practical learning opportunity. Students get the chance to closely collaborate with industry experts, acquiring hands-on knowledge and getting a taste of real-world difficulties. The duration for this internship program is of 1.5 to 2 years allowing the students to gain practical knowledge in their fields of interest. Till date, 20 distinguished companies have participated for hiring interns including Searchonic, Jegnus, Radaince Technologies, BrainyBeam Technologies Pvt. Ltd., NFLOW, Creative Chimps, etc. Radaince Technologies have offered the highest stipend of Rs 17000. More than 20 students have been selected till date. Several mock drives were organized for all the companies, aiming to help students practice and get ready for actual placements. On an average, 250 students participated in the mock drives and benefitted from the practice interviews.

1st internship Job fair was organized by the Training and Placement cell in collaboration with Jolly hires specifically tailored for BCA 4th semester students on 29th January, 2024 in which more than 130 students participated and renowned companies like iQlance, Ivory, and Web Mavens were invited.

Placement HIGHLIGHTS

For the batches of 2023 and 2024, over 50 renowned companies were extended invitations to participate in the final year placement drive. presently, more than 525 students have actively undertaken winter internships during their pre-final year, and over 1185 students have embarked on final semester internships. In total, there are currently 1700+ students engaged in winter internships and final semester project training in 400+ companies. noteworthy companies among the participating recruiters include HDFC Life, Srf Limited, Bajaj Allianz Life Insurance, Citrusbug Technolabs, Piramal Pharmaceutical, Techdefence Labs Solutions Pvt. Ltd., JP Solar Energy Pvt. Ltd., West-Coast Pharmaceutical Works Ltd., Bosch Rexroth India Pvt. Ltd., Biziverse Pvt Ltd, Addon Manpower Solutions, Goalseek Shared Services Pvt. 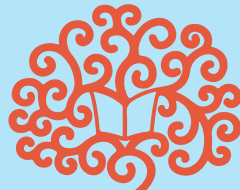
